TIME TO DRIVE THOSE CARS



First Cruise of 2021 – Flagstaff History (Saturday 2/27/2021)

This Cruise will run on a weather-permitting basis.

1. Meet in the parking lot in front of Peter Piper Pizza (1550 S Riordan Ranch St, Flagstaff, AZ 86001) at 10:00 AM on Saturday 2/27/2021
2. We will then drive through Historic NAU:
 - a. Exit the parking lot on University Ave. (Right)
 - b. Proceed East on University to Knoles Dr. (Left)
 - c. North on Knoles Dr. to Dupont Ave (Right)
 - d. East on Dupont Ave. to South San Francisco St. (Left)
3. Next, we will Cruise downtown:
 - a. North on San Francisco St to Birch Ave. (Right)
 - b. West on Birch Ave. to Beaver St. (Left)
 - c. South on Beaver St. to Aspen Ave. (Left)
 - d. East on Aspen Ave. to San Francisco St. (yes, we are going around the block!) (Left)
 - e. North on San Francisco St to Birch Ave. (Left)
 - f. West on Birch to Thorpe Rd. (Left)
 - g. South on Thorpe Rd. to W. Santa Fe Ave. (Right)
 - h. West (and up) West Mars Hill Road to Lowell Observatory (if permitted) or City Overlook
4. To Walnut Canyon
 - a. From Lowell Observatory (or City Overlook) East on Mars Hill Rd. to Thorpe (Left)
 - b. North on Thorpe to Aztec St. (Left)
 - c. North on Aztec St. to Beal Rd. (Right)
 - d. East on Beal Rd. to Navajo DR. (Left)
 - e. North on Navajo DR. to Whipple Rd. (Right)
 - f. East on Whipple Rd. to Fort Valley Rd. (Right)
 - g. South on Fort Valley to Forest Ave. (Left)
 - h. East on Forest Ave (Becomes Cedar Ave. and then Lockett Rd.) to Fanning Dr.
 - i. South on Fanning Dr. to Rte. 66 (Right)
 - j. East on Rte. 66 to intersection with W. Historic Rte. 66 (Right)
 - k. East on Historic Rte. 66 to Walnut Canyon Rd. (Right)

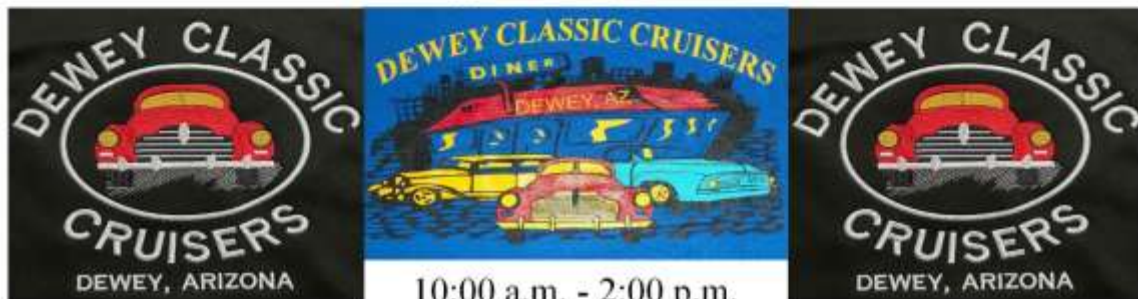
