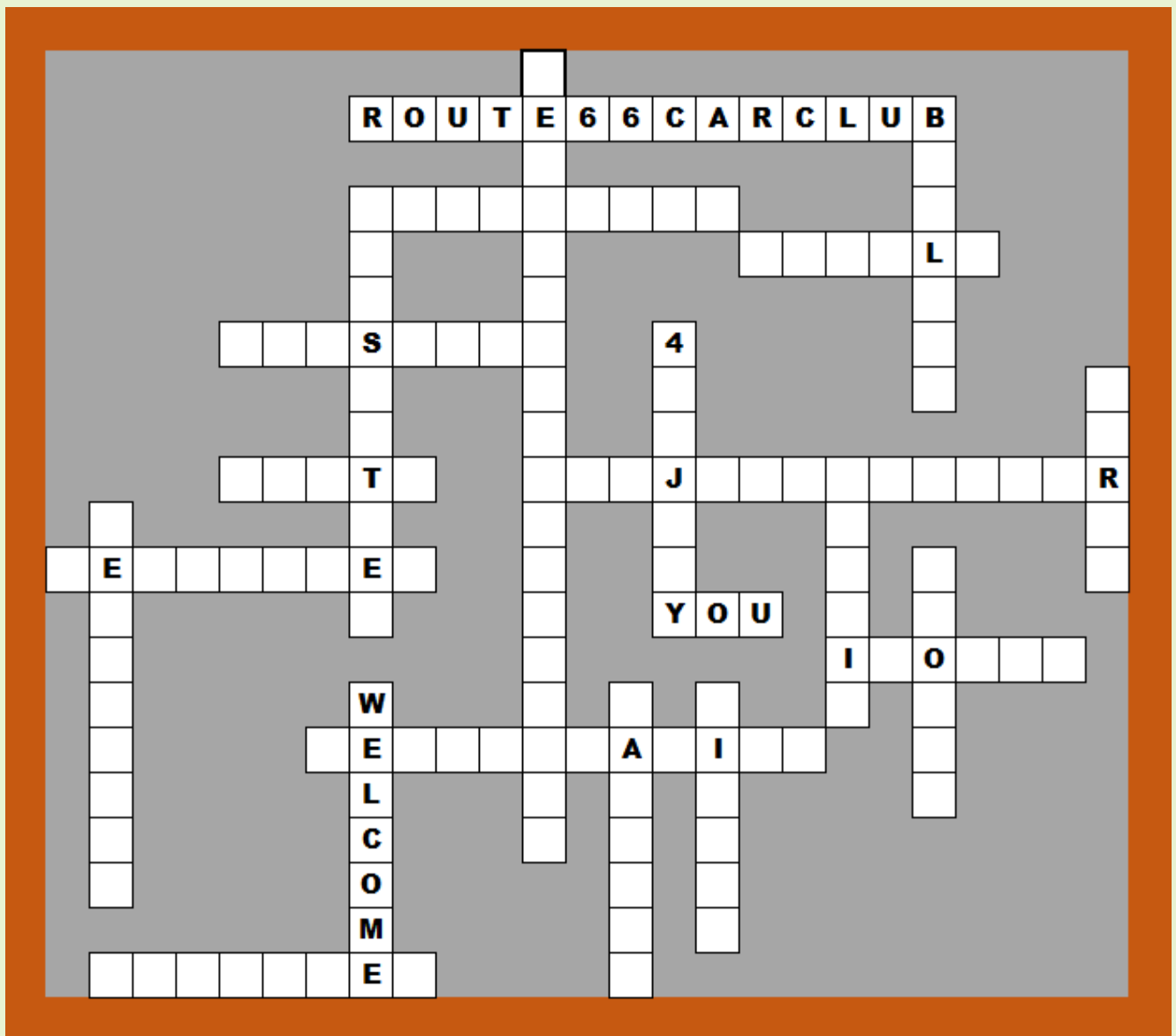

### ***Come on down.***

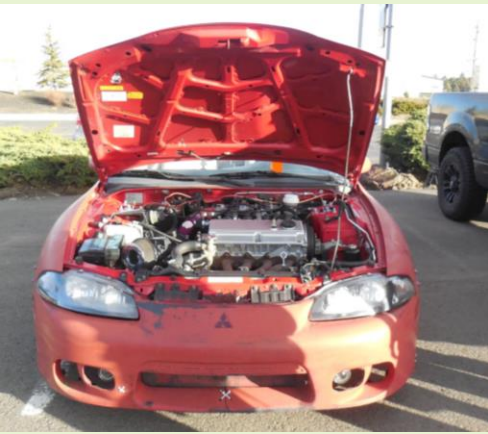
